

RESPITE HOME in MARBELLA, SPAIN

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Respite Home is in the centre of Marbella, 100 metres from the beach and 150 metres from the Old Town. It has all amenities such as shops, restaurant, chemist, public transport, etc on its doorstep.

The apartment sleeps 6 people with the following distribution:

- one double bedroom
- one bedroom with two single beds and
- one bedroom with two beds (one of which is a pull-out bed).

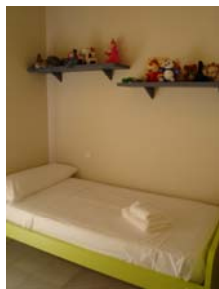
There are two bathrooms with baths, a fully equipped kitchen and a living-room. Moreover, the apartment has a big terrace with lovely views.

Both the apartment block and the apartment itself are wheelchair friendly – the only place in the apartment block which has steps is the swimming-pool area on the terraced roof.

In order to make your stay as comfortable as possible, the Respite Home has a wheelchair (not electric), a stretcher where wound-care can be carried out and a food mixer.

The duration of the stay at the Respite Home is for a week (or even two weeks on the condition that the person with EB requires help from the nurses. A two week stay will not be possible between the following dates: from 15th June to 15th September and during the Christmas season).

The arrival day is a Saturday (or later in the week, but not before Saturday) before 14:00 and the departure day is the following Friday before 15:00.



If you are interested in visiting our Respite Home, you should:

1. write to DEBRA Spain (e-mail: social@debra.es) and check the availability of the week you wish to visit. Once DEBRA Spain notifies you that the week is free,
2. fill in a registration form (which requires you to provide information about the number of people you will be travelling with, contact details of your national DEBRA, etc), and send it to social@debra.es
3. Once DEBRA Spain has received your registration form and confirmed your reservation, you will have to deposit, within the next 72 hours, 50€ in the following account number:

From this point, your reservation will be fully confirmed.

(All services provided by DEBRA Spain are free – the 50€ go towards paying the maintenance company which runs the apartment).

Once DEBRA Spain confirms your booking, they will also provide you with the contact details of the management company which will welcome you and give you the keys of the apartment.

Travel information:

Once you arrive at Malaga Airport, you have several options for getting to Marbella (which is 60 Km away).

1.- **By taxi:** from the Arrivals Terminal. The price is approximately 80€ and the journey takes about 45 minutes.

2.- **By bus:** it will leave you at the Marbella Bus Station. These buses run every hour at a price of 5 to 6€. Within the Arrivals hall, there is a ticket office. If it is closed, you can buy the tickets directly from the bus driver. The bus stop is straight outside the arrivals terminal. The journey takes 45 minutes. From the Bus Station to the Respite Home you can take a taxi which you will find just outside the Bus Station. The journey takes about 5 minutes.

3.- **Rent a car:** there are many rental companies within the airport, just before you exit the Arrivals Terminal.

Driving from Málaga

- Take the Mediterráneo highway (A7)
- Take Exit nº 184 (Marbella centro urbano/ Pol. Industrial)
- Once you have driven under a big “Marbella” white arch, carry straight on. After about 1km you will see, on your left, the USP hospital, carry straight on and after 800 metres take the road on the right hand side. The entrance to the respite home is 25metres on the left hand side of the road.



Relevant information:

The two DEBRA nurses will help you and your family as much as you wish, including advice about wounds, bandaging material, etc, and, if you request it in the registration form, more hands-on help with wound care. It is very important that you bring your own bandaging material with you because although the nurses will have bandaging material available, bandaging material differs from country to country and you may find they don't have what you usually use.



Thanks to a grant from Ryanair, DEBRA Spain, together with DEBRA Ireland, will pay those people with EB with financial need, up to a maximum of 100€ of travel costs for the person with EB. Funds for travel costs of relatives are not available.

The procedure for re-imbusement of travel costs is the following:

1. book your travel itinerary (plane, train, car, etc)
2. once you arrive in Marbella, Spain, bring the invoices to the DEBRA office, which is a 10 minute walk from the respite home, and you will be re-imbursed accordingly.
