

### How this book came about

This book was inspired by a boy called Shane whose brother Anthony was born with epidermolysis bullosa (EB). Shane wanted to understand why his brother needed to be treated gently and needed so much attention.

Inspiration for the Debra the Zebra character came from a crocheted Zebra that had been made for a window display in a DEBRA charity shop. This sparked the idea to create a story book featuring Debra the Zebra as the lead character who plans an adventure themed birthday party and in doing so talks about some of the challenges of living with EB.

Workshops were held with DEBRA members with lived experience of EB, DEBRA staff, and EB specialist clinicians. Their input and ideas helped shape the Debra the Zebra story. This story is about friendship, finding solutions, and playing to your strengths even if you live with a medical condition like EB and some aspects of day-to-day life are challenging.

We hope you enjoy reading it and find it a useful resource to help young children, schools and extended family better understand EB.

### What is EB?


My skin blisters super quickly and can tear at the slightest touch.





My skin gets sore and itchy.


Some parts of me have no skin. This really hurts.

My favourite is sleeping explorers.




# Rules of the game

### About EB

Epidermolysis bullosa (EB) is an incredibly painful genetic skin blistering condition. It causes the skin to blister and tear at the slightest touch. With skin as fragile as butterfly's wings, it is often referred to as 'butterfly skin'.

EB can affect the hands and feet only or in the most severe cases any part of the body, including blistering on the eyes and internal organs.



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
