You may have seen the news that since we launched our A Life Free of Pain appeal back in October 2022, you have helped to raise over £5m to help stop the pain of EB. There is still much to do but it is hugely satisfying to have secured this funding which has enabled us to invest in our first drug repurposing clinical trial.

I'd like to extend a heartfelt thank you on behalf of everyone at DEBRA UK and the EB community.

Not forgetting those individuals who took on challenges and the people who sponsored them, our lottery players, regular givers, corporate partners, grants from Trusts and Foundations and those who left gifts in their Wills. 14 new EB research projects awarded funding in 2023





We're delighted to share that DEBRA UK received close to 30 applications for EB research funding in 2023 because of our first open call to researchers in the UK and around the world.

Thanks to your support, we have awarded funding to seven exciting new projects that will run for two-to-three years, five small grants to fund single-year projects, and our first two non-clinical PhD students. These four-year PhD studentships will bring vital new researchers into the field of EB.

This impressive addition to our research portfolio would not have been possible

without supporters like you. Thank you for enabling DEBRA UK to continue the essential research into drug repurposing and treatments that could help stop the pain for all types of EB.

Filsuvez® marks UK's first EB drug treatment for DEB and JEB

In September, Filsuvez® became the UK's first approved drug for the treatment of partial thickness wounds associated with dystrophic EB (DEB) and junctional EB (JEB).

Amryt Pharma, DEBRA UK, and crucially our members, contributed significantly to this decision. DEBRA UK members' firsthand accounts highlighted unmet needs and the impact of EB on daily life.

Their testimonies revealed the profound struggles of living

with EB, such as how the time spent on dressing changes was like a full-time job, and the severe pain. We would like to thank our members for their impactful testimonies.






QMUL, UK, 2024-2028
